Welcome to William T. Foster Woods, a beautiful natural area on the Humber River. Established in 1992 as a passive open space and woodlot, this property was given to Toronto and Region Conservation (TRCA) by the City of Vaughan with consultation from Kleinburg and Area Ratepayers Association.

William T. Foster Woods is a 17.8 hectare property in the City of Vaughan, Region of York. The property offers a mix of both meadow and forested areas and supports a variety of flora and fauna for trail users to enjoy.

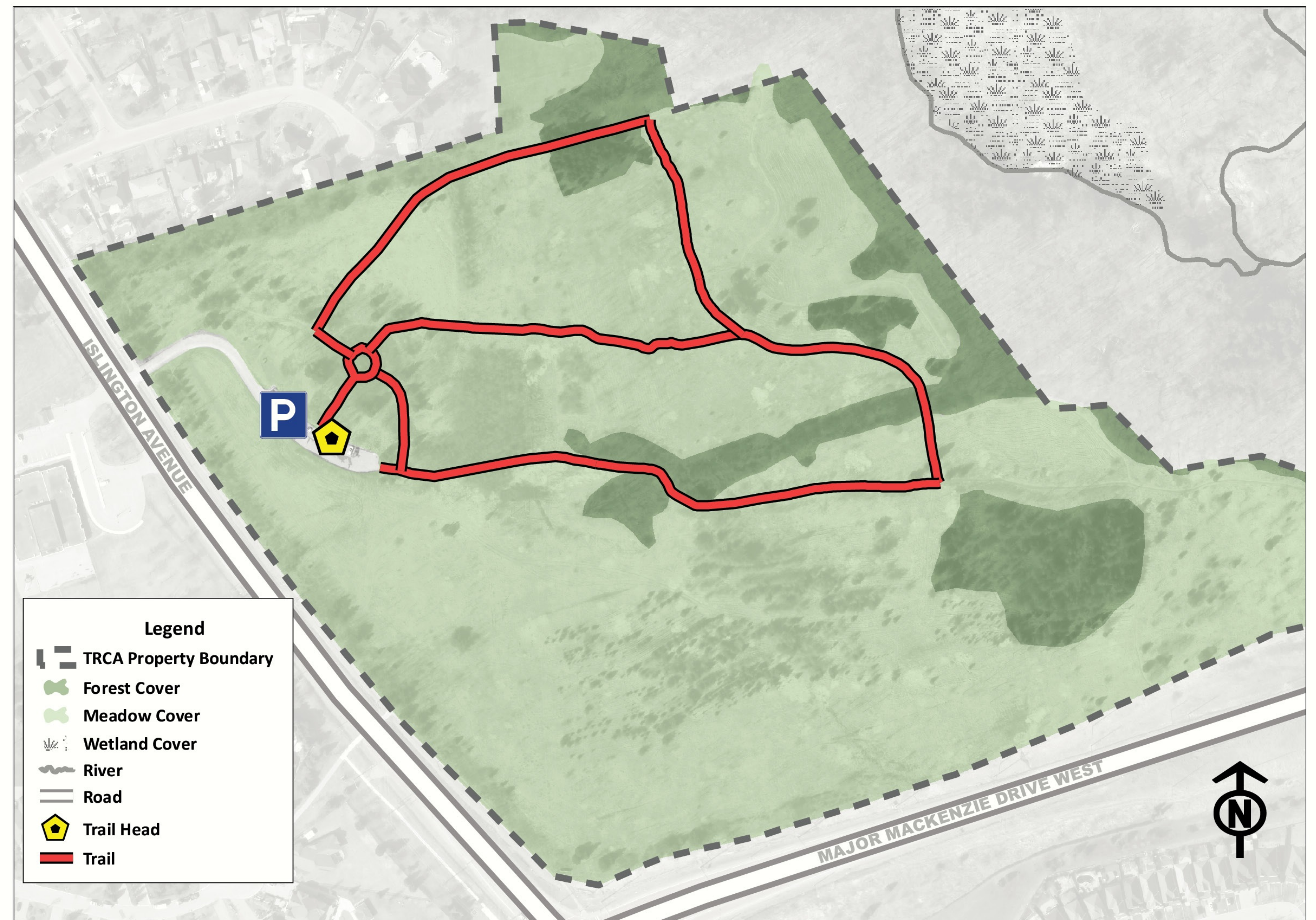
