NOTICE OF INTENT

BLUFFER'S PARK SOUTHWEST HEADLAND AND BEACH MAJOR MAINTENANCE PROJECT CITY OF TORONTO

Toronto and Region Conservation Authority (TRCA) has commenced a study to determine the preferred method of repairing and restoring the southwest headland and adjacent beach at Bluffer's Park to provide long term protection to Bluffer's Park Marina and the park interior.

These shoreline erosion control structures were originally built in the late 1970's as part of the construction of Bluffer's Park. Over the past 45 years, these structures have deteriorated through the displacement of armourstone, the loss of beach material due to abrasion, the erosion of backshore material, wave overtopping and ice effects.


This project is being planned in accordance with Conservation Ontario's Class Environmental Assessment for Remedial Flood and Erosion Control Projects(2002 - amended 2013).
