
## NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

## Claireville North Multi-use Trail Project



Start Date: February 2020 Completion Date: Spring 2022\*

The Toronto and Region Conservation Authority (TRCA), in partnership with the City of Brampton, is constructing the Claireville North Multi-use Trail Project within TRCA's Claireville Conservation Area (CCA) property. Scope of work includes building 3.8 kilometres of granular multi-use trail, including the installation of two pedestrian bridges across the West Humber River.

Development of the Claireville North Multi-use Trail Project is a key recommendation of the CCA Management Plan Update (2012), the TRCA Trail Strategy (2019) and Brampton's Active Transportation Master Plan (2019). The Management Plan Update was developed in collaboration with the Humber Watershed Alliance, municipal partners and the general public. Once complete, the trail will offer improved access to CCA and provide greater interregional trail connectivity between the City of Brampton and the City of Toronto.

Construction activities in this area commenced February 2020. To ensure public safety, sections of trail within the limits of construction will be closed for the duration of the project. Please respect all posted construction signs and stay clear of work areas and equipment. Your cooperation and patience is appreciated.
