

## BLUFFER'S PARK SOUTH HEADLAND AND BEACH MAJOR MAINTENANCE PROJECT

Phase IV - Beach WF22.03 Long-Term Works

Start Date: June 2021

**Completion Date:** December 2021\*

Toronto and Region Conservation Authority (TRCA), in partnership with the City of Toronto, is undertaking major maintenance works on erosion control structures in Bluffer's Park. The objective of the works is to stabilize existing erosion control structures to protect against the hazards of shoreline erosion and reduce the risk to public safety. The project is being funded in part by the City of Toronto Parks, Forestry and Recreation Division and by infrastructure Canada's Disaster Mitigation and Adaptation Fund as part of a City wide shoreline protection effort.

Phase IV of the work is scheduled to commence in June 2021, pending the receipt of necessary permits and approvals, and is anticipated to be completed by December 2021. This work will involve the long-term repair of the beach (WF22.03) that is located west of the recently completed headland (WF22.04) and east beach (WF22.05) works.

To ensure public safety, the construction area shown in red will be closed for the duration of the work. In an effort to provide the public with access to the shoreline, the limits of the access road shown in yellow will be opened during the evenings and on weekends. For your safety, please respect all posted construction signs and stay clear of the work areas and equipment. Your cooperation and patience with this undertaking is appreciated.
