Toronto and Region Conservation Authority (TRCA), in partnership with the City of Toronto, is undertaking major maintenance works on an erosion control structure in Bluffer's Park. The project is being funded in part by Infrastructure Canada's Disaster Mitigation and Adaptation Fund.

Prior phases of this project involved interim works on the headland in 2016, as well as major maintenance on the beach northeast of the headland in 2018. Phase III, the final phase of this project, involves major maintenance on the headland. This structure is in a failing condition due to wave activity over time. The objective of the work is to repair the existing headland erosion control structure to protect against the hazards of erosion and reduce the risk to public safety.

Construction is scheduled to commence June 2023, pending receipt of necessary permits and approvals, and is anticipated to be complete by August 2024.

To ensure public safety, the project area (shown in red on the map) will remain closed for the duration of the work. For your safety, please respect all posted signs and stay clear of the work area and equipment. Your cooperation and patience with this undertaking is appreciated.
