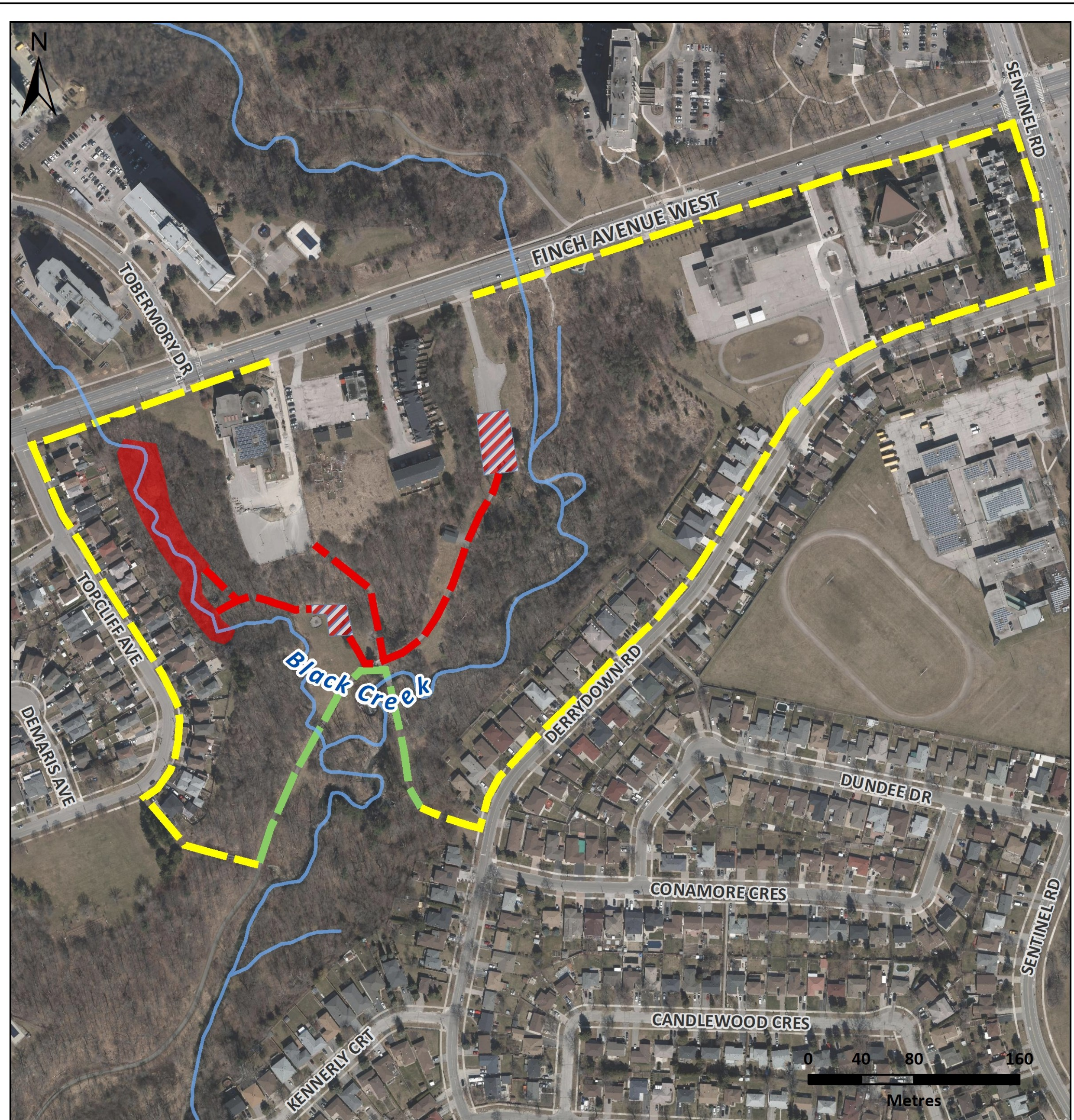

Start Date: February 2024* | **Completion Date:** October 2024*

Toronto and Region Conservation Authority (TRCA) is implementing erosion control and slope stabilization works to in Derrydowns Park, on the creek bed and valley slope behind Topcliff Avenue. Sections of Black Creek Trail south of Finch Avenue West will be closed for the duration of the work. See map for detour routes. This work is necessary to protect essential structures located at the top of slope.
