The Wilket Creek Geomorphic & Habitat Systems Master Plan is being undertaken by the City of Toronto and Toronto and Region Conservation Authority (TRCA).

The aim of the project is to develop a long-term management plan for Wilket Creek that takes account of natural processes, wildlife habitat and public amenity. In particular, the project will protect infrastructure at risk of erosion, including exposed manholes, pedestrian bridges and pathways while working with natural channel processes.

Current Focus of the Study

The current focus of the long-term study is the area upstream of Lawrence Avenue, with specific concern regarding the at-risk infrastructure, as well as locations along the watercourse where infrastructure may be at-risk in the near future.

The purpose of the focus group meeting is to discuss the findings of the preliminary investigation works for the area north of Lawrence Avenue, and next steps regarding the process.
