Ajax Shoreline Project: Project Restoration

Date: July 2026 - Fall 2026

Toronto and Region Conservation Authority completed in-water shoreline restoration work at Ajax Waterfront Park at the end of June.

During July, restoration activities include restoring the access route, topsoiling the staging and stockpiling area, repaving a section of trail, and demobilizing heavy equipment and site facilities.

Fencing will remain around the staging and stockpiling area until grass seeding and planting activities can take place during optimal growing conditions in Fall 2026. Please stay clear of closed areas to help support the success of these restoration efforts.

The Waterfront Trail will remain open during restoration work.
