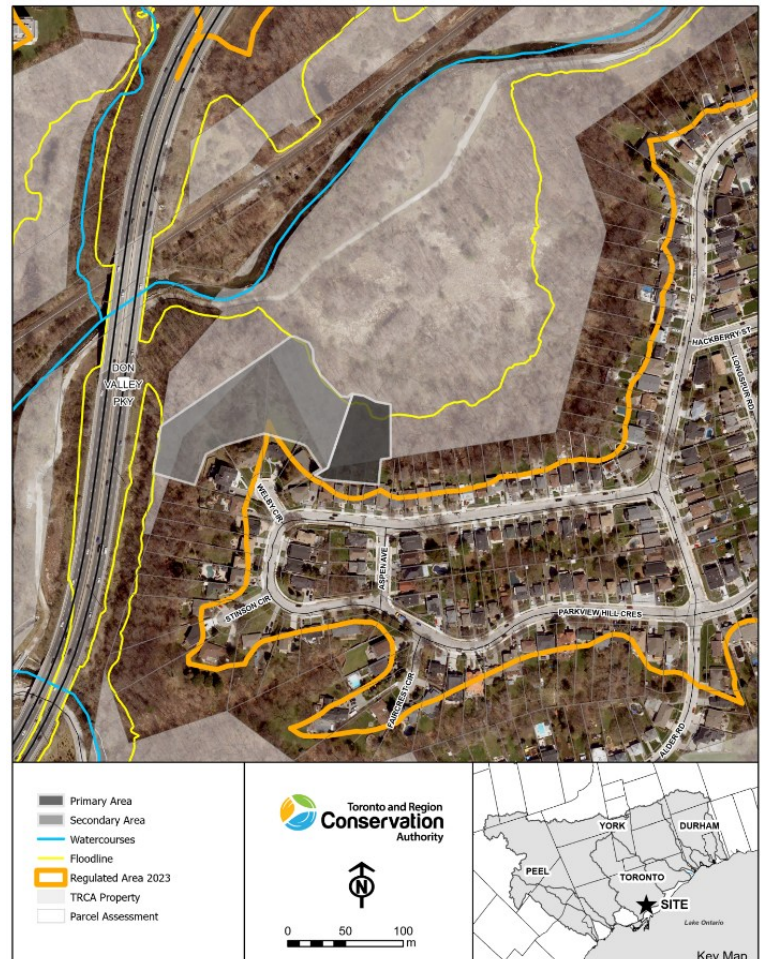
PARKVIEW HILL CRESCENT SLOPE STABILIZATION PROJECT
