

What's your experience in Tommy Thompson Park and on the Leslie Street Spit?

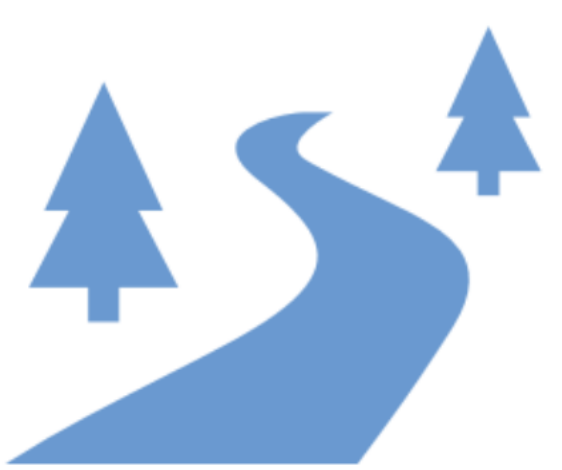

The Visitor Experience Plan will work within the Tommy Thompson Park Master Plan which aims to create, enhance, restore and protect the natural features of the manmade landscape while providing recreational opportunities for all.

The Visitor Experience Plan will:



Gather input from the public, Indigenous communities, and experts



Assess the existing state of visitor experience at Tommy Thompson Park and on the Leslie Street Spit



Recommend enhancements to facilities, programs, operations, and communities



Create an action plan with clear priorities, high-level costs, and timelines



Present a final Visitor Experience Plan that is clear, engaging, and inspiring!

Community engagement will include public open houses and online surveys starting in early 2026. A Community Advisory Group is also being established.

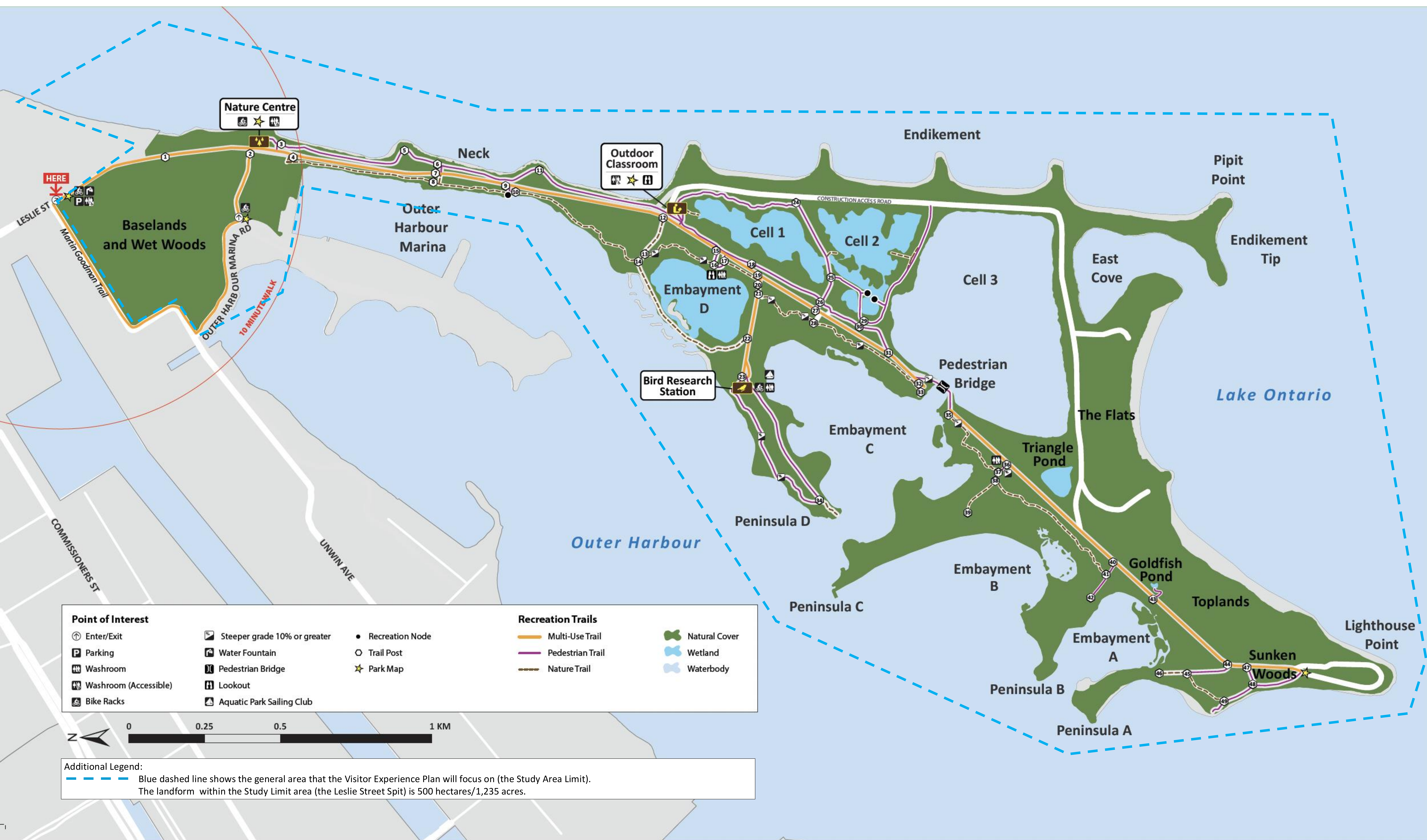

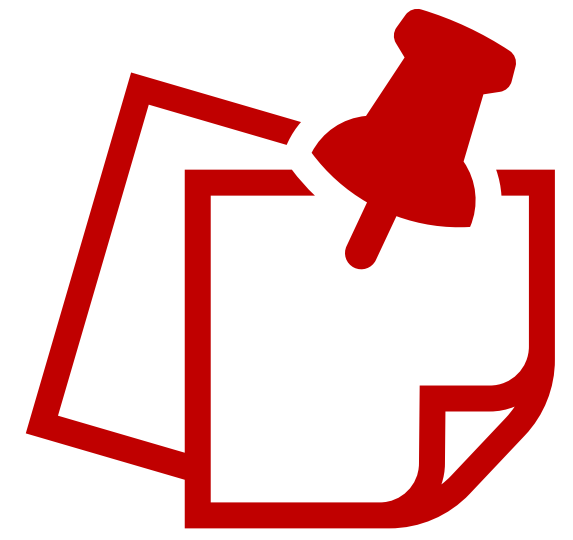
