

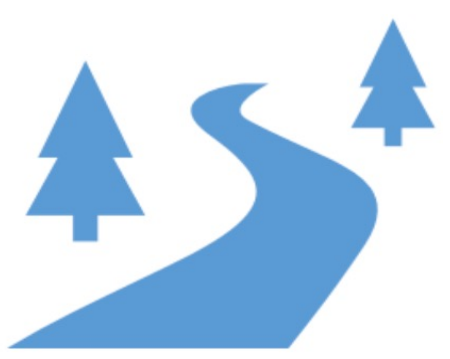
What's your experience in Tommy Thompson Park and on the Leslie Street Spit?

Present a final Visitor Experience Plan that is clear, engaging, and inspiring!

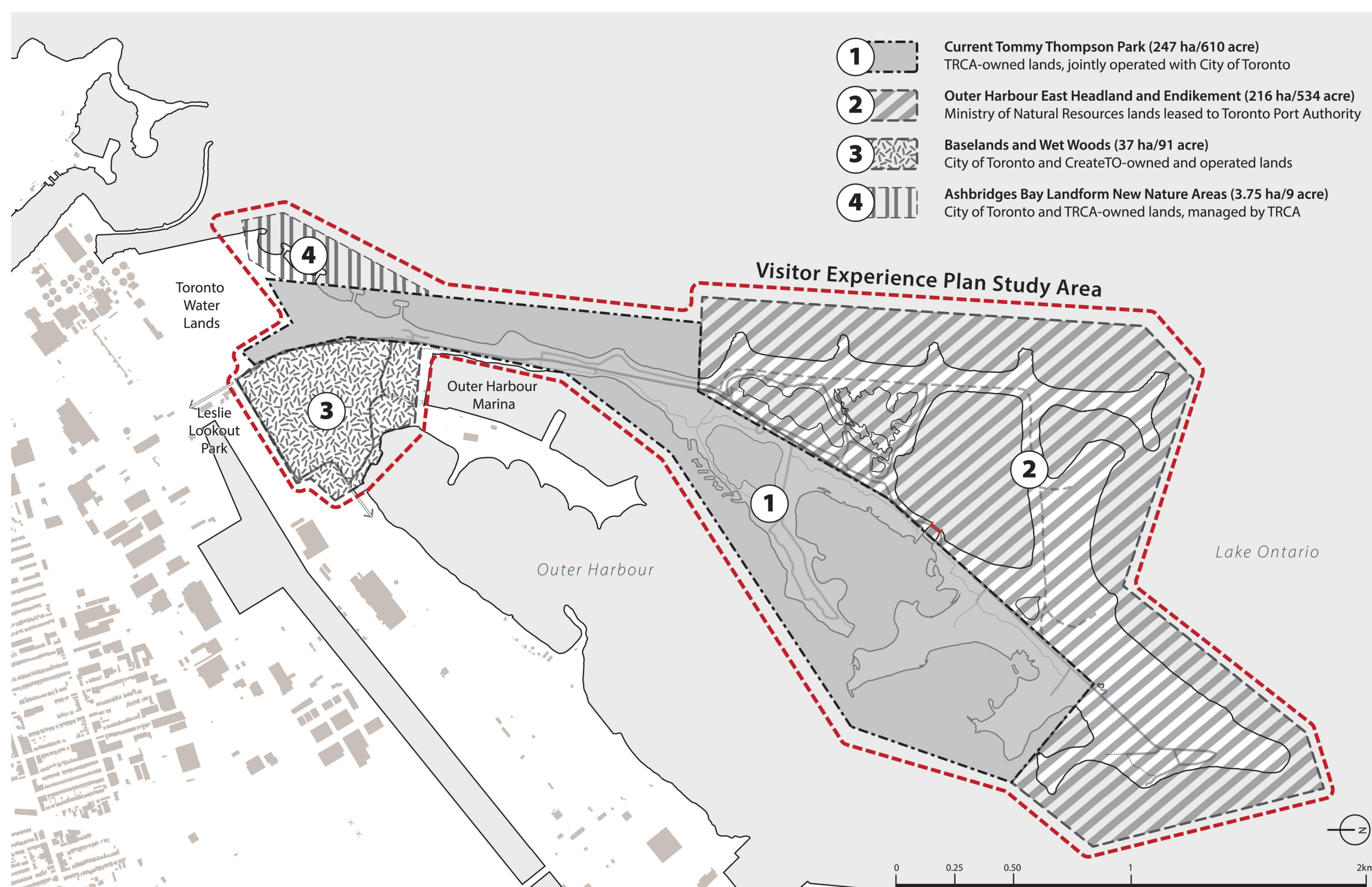
